The concept “climate” refers to the predominant or average weather recorded in a given area for long time. The climate depends on several interrelated factors: latitude, longitude, elevation, topography, proximity to the sea and wind direction. Therefore, although the areas located near the equator are usually warm, there are mountain zones on the same latitude that are cold.

In general, there are three types of climate: warm, temperate, and polar.

Group A: Tropical climate are near the Equator .It always hot and wet in these areas and rainforests grow there.

Group B: Dry climate is in the areas where there is less than 25 cm of rain each year which is called desert climate (during the day is very hot, but at night it becomes very cold) North Africa and central Australia are examples.

Group C: Moderate climate is in the areas around the Mediterranean.

It is warm to hot climate. While winters are rainy, summers are dry. Regions with this climate are usually in the eastern part of the continents. They experience hot, humid summers and colder winters.
